**ENDED – High Streamflow Advisory – Lower Nicola River, Coldwater River**  
**UPDATED: 7:30 AM November 19, 2021**

The River Forecast Centre is **ending to High Streamflow Advisories** for:

- **Lower Nicola River**
- **Coldwater River**

River levels through the region have receded down to near pre-event levels. No significant additional rises in flows are expected at this time.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period.

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
