Downgraded: High Streamflow Advisory – Nass River

The River Forecast Centre is **downgrading** the **Flood Watch** to a **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Nass River**

Responding to the high temperatures in this region early this week, the NASS RIVER ABOVE SHUMAL CREEK (08DB001) has peaked at a flow slightly below the 10-year return period last night and is dropping now. Based on the current hydrological modeling, the river is expected to drop further today into the weekend, even though minor rises could be possible. The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period.

BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
