ENDED – Flood Watch – Moberly Creek

The BC River Forecast Centre is **ending** the Flood Watch for the Moberly River and Moberly Lake near Fort St. John

River and lake levels have been high through the week in response to rainfall and snowmelt throughout the week. River levels on the Moberly River near Fort St. John Water Survey of Canada gauge (07FB008) crested late-Thursday, and have been receding since Friday. River and lake levels are expected to continue to recede through the weekend.

The River Forecast Centre will continue to monitor conditions and will provide an update as warranted.

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
