ENDED- High Streamflow Advisory – Lower Thompson Tributaries, Bonaparte River

ISSUED: 11:45 AM May 10, 2021

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** a **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Lower Thompson Tributaries including Guichon Creek, Deadman River and tributaries around Savona, Cache Creek, Ashcroft and Logan Lake**
- **Bonaparte River**

River flows have remained high throughout the region due to on-going snowmelt and unsettled weather. Rivers have seen some stabilization or declines in flows over the weekend. Some rivers continue to have high flows (around 2-year return period flows), however have receded from peak levels that were experienced earlier in May. Flow are expected to remain high, however significant additional rises are not expected at this time.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period.

BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
