The River Forecast Centre is ending a High Streamflow Advisory for:

Tributaries around Prince George and Mackenzie, including areas around Bear Lake,
Aleza Lake, Giscome, the Cottonwood River, Chilako River, Salmon River, Willow River,
Pack River and surrounding areas

Flows through the region have been easing since the weekend. Mixed weather is expected over the rest of this weekend and weekend. River conditions are expected to continue to recede.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period.

The <u>River Forecast Centre</u> continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A *High Streamflow Advisory* means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A *Flood Watch* means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A *Flood Warning* means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
