Ended: High Streamflow Advisory – Peace Region and Liard River

Ended: 11:30 AM June 7, 2021

The River Forecast Centre is **Ending** the **High Streamflow Advisory** for the Peace region and the Liard River, including:

- **Rivers draining into the Williston Lake**
- **The Pine River and tributaries**
- **COTTONWOOD RIVER ABOVE BASS CREEK (10AC005)**
- **Liard River and tributaries above the Hyland River**

Rivers in the above regions have peaked at flows about the 5-year return period on the past weekend. Based on the current hydrological modeling, the river levels are expected to drop further this week, though minor rises are possible. BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
