ENDED: High Streamflow Advisory – Coldwater, Lower Nicola, Spius

ISSUED: 7:45 AM December 4, 2021

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** a **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Coldwater River**
- **Lower Nicola River**
- **Spius Creek**

River levels have continued to recede through the Nicola River and tributaries. Colder weather over the weekend will promote continued stabilization of river levels over the weekend and into next week.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period.

BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
