**Ended – High Streamflow Advisory – Skeena River, Bulkley River  
ISSUED: 1:35 PM July 8, 2022**

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** a **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Skeena River including the Bulkley River and surrounding tributaries around Telkwa, Smithers, Hazelton, Kispiox, and Terrace**

Light to moderate precipitation within the Bulkley and Skeena watersheds over the past couple days. Modest increases in flow were observed but water levels remained significantly lower than the peaks of the season in early June.

The public is advised to stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks during the high-streamflow period. [Be prepared and know your hazards.](#)

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
