**Ended: High Streamflow Advisory – Upper Fraser and Lower Thompson**

**Ended: 12:01 PM July 15, 2022**

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** the **High Streamflow Advisory** for:

- **Upper Fraser River including areas from Prince George and upstream tributaries through the Robson Valley and the McGregor River; Fraser River from Prince George to Quesnel**
- **Thompson River from Kamloops to Spences Bridge**

The above rivers continue to recede below levels of concern (about the 2-year return period), Slightly rising could be possible due to localized storms, but significant rises in these rivers are not expected for the next days.

The public is advised to approach the rivers cautiously and stay clear of the fast-flowing rivers and potentially unstable riverbanks if the actual river levels stay high. [Be prepared and know your hazards.](#)

The [River Forecast Centre](#) continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
