UPDATE: Flood Warning – Beattoon River (MAINTAINED)

ENDED - High Streamflow Advisory – Peace

The River Forecast Centre is **maintaining** a Flood Warning for:

- Beattoon River (NEW)

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** a High Streamflow Advisory for:

- Peace Region including areas around Hudson's Hope, Chetwynd, Tumbler Ridge, Dawson Creek, Fort St. John and surrounding areas

Weather Synopsis:

Heavy rainfall over the weekend has tapered off. On-going thundershowers are possible, with additional rainfall forecasted through this week.

River Conditions:

Rivers in the area are mostly reached peak levels from the weekend rainfall and are now receding. On the Beattoon River, very high flows are being captured at the Water Survey of Canada gauge at Tommy Lakes Road (WSC Gauge 07FC008). Flows are expected to slowly recede through the early part of this week.

BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Fast-flowing bodies of water increase risk to life safety. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
