**UPDATE:** Flood Warning – Canoe River Issued: 2:30 PM September 25, 2024

The River Forecast Centre is upgrading to a Flood Warning for:

• Canoe River and tributary rivers around the northern end of Kinbasket Lake

As of 1:30 pm PDT September 25, the Water Survey of Canada gauge on the Canoe River south of Valemount (Canoe River below Kimmel Creek, gauge ID 08NC004) recorded flows of approximately 145 m3/s, corresponding to the 50-year return period. The river level is expected to continue to rise with ongoing precipitation.

Fast-flowing rivers pose increased risk to life safety. The <u>River Forecast Centre</u> continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A *High Streamflow Advisory* means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Fast-flowing bodies of water increase risk to life safety. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A *Flood Watch* means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas

adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A *Flood Warning* means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
