High Streamflow Advisory – Kingcome River (DOWNGRADED) Issued: 10:30 AM November 9, 2024

The River Forecast Centre is downgrading to a High Streamflow Advisory for:

Kingcome River

Weather Synopsis:

A storm system past across the BC coast yesterday, bringing moderate to heavy precipitation to much of the Central Coast. Subsequent storms are expected during the weekend and into next week.

River Conditions:

Water levels in the Kingcome River peaked and are receding. River levels remain high and are expected to remain elevated with on-going rainfall through the weekend and early part of next week.

Fast-flowing rivers pose increased risk to life safety. The <u>River Forecast Centre</u> continues to monitor the conditions and will provide updates as conditions warrant.

A *High Streamflow Advisory* means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Fast-flowing bodies of water increase risk to life safety. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible. A *Flood Watch* means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A *Flood Warning* means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
