ENDED - High Streamflow Advisory – Central Interior

The River Forecast Centre is **ending** a **High Streamflow Advisory** for the Central Interior including:

- Chilcotin River
- Pemberton and its upstream watersheds
- Bridge River
- Cariboo Region

River Conditions:

River levels have stabilized across the region and are generally receding. Additional rises are not expected at this time.

Fast-flowing rivers pose increased risk to safety. Stay away from rivers and riverbanks, which can be unstable. Never drive through floodwaters, as unseen hazards and current can be life-threatening.

BC River Forecast Centre

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A **High Streamflow Advisory** means that river levels are rising or expected to rise rapidly, but that no major flooding is expected. Fast-flowing bodies of water increase risk to life safety. Minor flooding in low-lying areas is possible.

A **Flood Watch** means that river levels are rising and will approach or may exceed bankfull. Flooding of areas adjacent to affected rivers may occur.

A **Flood Warning** means that river levels have exceeded bankfull or will exceed bankfull imminently, and that flooding of areas adjacent to the rivers affected will result.
